A ground-breaking initiative in Malaga aimed at offering individuals and businesses access to e-mobility. The 198 e-vehicles included in the project now operating in Malaga have avoided the emission of over 200 million tonnes of CO₂ into the atmosphere compared to using conventional combustion-engine vehicles.
